





The TUI Care Foundation in partnership with Severin Craftsman Training Centre (SCTC), launched the TUI Academy Kenya. The Centre is licensed by TVET (Technical and Vocational Education Training,) and offers three years of vocational training for electricians, plumbers, carpenters, masons, and metal workers. The Training Center applies the German concept of the Duales system whereby theory and practice go hand in hand.

All trainees are between 19 and 26 years old and recruited from the neighboring villages, with a particular focus on women, and finished their secondary school but cannot afford to continue with higher education.

The training prepares the students for the job market and the skills gained can be utilized in self-employment which in turn solves the problem of youth unemployment within the Kenyan coastal communities. This boosts the economy in the region and improves the livelihoods of the communities.





Train 90 craftsmen to become electricians, plumbers, carpenters, masons and metal workers.



Train 90 craftsmen in life skills coaching (opening a bank account, learning the basics of the income statement and preparing their tax return, etc.).



Exam 90 craftsmen to achieve the NITA (National Industrial Training Authority)
Level 1 certificate and the AHK Class-C certificate issued by the German foreign trade chamber.



Partner with 3 hotels for practical training.



Secure employment for 80% of the graduated craftsmen.
